He was born in Peru and came to the United States in 2000, when he was 17 years old. He graduated from Farmingdale High School in 2001. Luis attended Nassau Community College where he received an Associate's Degree in Media and then transferred to Hunter College where he graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Media Studies.

He started working as a reporter for the weekly Hispanic publication, Noticia in 2004, then as a local editor for the same paper and is now working as the online editor for noticiali.com.

As a reporter, he has been informing the Hispanic community on Long Island about current issues that they need to be aware of in order to make important decisions in their lives.

He also works for Long Island Wins, a communication organization that advocates for immigrant rights and highlights the contributions of immigrants on Long Island. He is also the Director of Estampas Folkloricas Peru, a Peruvian folklore dance organization that diffuses Peruvian culture through dance performances on Long Island, New York City and other States. As a teacher, choreographer and performer for a Peruvian cultural organization, he has helped his students -some of Peruvian decent and some immigrants- to discover their identity and make it stronger. It used to be that the Republican Party was in favor of free trade, with the support of the influential US Chamber of Commerce, the largest business organization. By contrast, the Democratic Party was skeptical about the benefits of international free trade, responding to the support of the big union federations.

Now, the President and Chief Executive of the Chamber of Commerce, Thomas J. Donohue has written and op-ed in The Washington Post (July 2, 2016) saying both presidential candidates of the major parties are wrong about international trade.

President Donohue criticizes the proposals presented by the Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump to build tariff walls, to tear up free trade agreements and for wanting to turn the US economy inward. Additionally, the Democratic Party presidential nominee Hillary Clinton is also criticized, by the head of the Chamber of Commerce, for withdrawing her support to the recently negotiated Trans-Pacific Partnership, which she promoted as Secretary of State, during President Barack Obama's first term.

This turn away from international trade by both political parties, the head of the Chamber of Commerce concludes, is a threat for the US economy and for the more than 40 million US jobs tied to international trade. Therefore he says, it is time "to build bridges, not walls."
