El Regalo de la Presencia






LABOR MARKET 12/09/25

The next meeting of the US central bank's Open Market Committee begins today in Washington, without the latest labor market figures, which are delayed by the recent government shutdown. Anyhow, available statistics on employment in September revealed the creation of 119,000 new jobs, an exceptionally strong figure, since monthly job creation in the last four months, between May and August, reached only 27,000. Even so, the unemployment rate increased to 4.4

According to the head of the Federal Reserve, Jerome Powell, the US labor market is in a “curious kind of balance,” because both labor supply and demand have slowed down. For various reasons, such as tariffs and restrictive immigration policies, several companies have announced job cuts, including the United Postal Service (48,000) and Amazon (14,000), while the federal government has lost 97,000 jobs since January. Furthermore, in September, job growth was primarily concentrated in the services sector, such as healthcare and hospitality, while transportation and manufacturing lost jobs. Additionally, rather than the expected boost in employment, immigration restrictions and workplace raids are creating labor shortages in some sectors. Columnist Jason Riley, in the Wall Street Journal (09/17/25), asked the following question: with the border secured, where are the new jobs?



Además, el crecimiento del empleo en septiembre se concentró en los servicios, como la sanidad y la hospitalidad, mientras que el transporte y la manufactura perdieron empleos. También, en vez del esperado auge del empleo, las restricciones migratorias y las redadas en los lugares de trabajo han generado escasez de mano de obra en algunos sectores.
